**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN**

AN ACT to Confer Jurisdiction in Equity upon the Probate
Courts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The courts of probate shall have jurisdiction in equity
2 concurrent with the supreme judicial court of all cases and
3 matters relating to the administration of the estates of de-
4 ceased persons, to wills, and to trusts which are created by
5 will or other written instrument. Such jurisdiction may
6 be exercised upon bill or petition according to the usual
7 course of proceedings in equity.
