STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section thirty-two of Chapter sixty-nine of
the Revised Statutes Relating to Petitions for Adoption of
Children.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section thirty-two of chapter sixty-nine of the revised stat-
2 utes is hereby amended by adding thereto the following sen-
3 tence: 'Any unmarried inhabitant of another state or any
4 non-resident husband and wife jointly, may present such
5 petition in the probate court for the county where such child
6 lives,' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 32. Any unmarried inhabitant of the state or any
8 husband and wife jointly, may petition the judge of pro-
9 bate for their county for leave to adopt a child not theirs

10 by birth and for a change of his name. Any unmarried
11 inhabitant of another state, or any non-resident husband
12 and wife jointly, may present such petition in the probate
13 court of the county where such child lives.'
