AN ACT to Provide for the Record in the Registry of Deeds of Notices Waiving Testamentary Provisions for Husband or Wife.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Within thirty days after any notice provided for in sec
2 tions twelve and thirteen of chapter seventy-seven of the

3 revised statutes is filed in the probate office, the register of

4 probate shall file in the registry of deeds for the county or

5 registry district in which any real estate of the deceased is

6 situated, an attested copy of such notice, and the register

7 of deeds shall receive and record the same as abstracts of

8 wills are received and recorded. The fees for making and

9 recording said copy shall be the same as for making and

10 recording abstracts of wills.
