HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" TO HOUSE DOCUMENT
NO. 691.

Amend House Document Number 691 by striking out from
2 lines nine and ten in said bill the words "neither the statute
3 of limitations or the provisions of section sixty-three, chap-
4 ter nine of the revised statutes" and inserting in place
5 thereof the words 'the statute of limitations is not,' so that
6 said resolution as amended shall read as follows:

Resolved, that DeForest Keyes be authorized to bring a
8 suit at law or in equity in the Supreme Judicial Court for
9 Kennebec County against the State of Maine for a balance
10 claimed to be due him by reason of his having paid to the
11 state certain money in the year nineteen hundred and two

12 and nineteen hundred and three for tax titles. Any judg-
13 ment that may be recovered in such suit shall be payable
14 from the state treasury out of any money not otherwise ap-
15 propriated. The statute of limitations is not to be invoked
16 in defense of the claim.

If the suit is in equity the court to determine what, if any-
18 thing, should be added for expense and counsel fees.
