STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section 72 of Chapter four of the Revised Statutes of Maine as amended by Chapter 160 of the Acts and Resolves of 1909, by inserting after the word "day" in the fifth line of said Article 72 the words 'Firemen's Mémorial Sunday,' so that said section as amended shall read as follows.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Cities and towns may raise money to procure the writing 2 and publication of their histories, to celebrate any centennial 3 or other anniversary of the settlement or incorporation of 4 such city or town, and to publish the proceedings of any 5 such celebration; to defray the expenses of the observance

6 of Memorial Day, Firemen's Memorial Sunday and of Old 7 Home Week, and a sum not exceeding five thousand dollars 8 in any one town for erecting a suitable monument in memory ory of the soldiers and sailors who sacrificed their lives in 10 defence of their country in the war of eighteen hundred and 11 sixty-one, and a reasonable sum to secure, grade and care 12 for a lot appropriate for such a monument.
