STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of Kennebec County issuing bonds.

Resolved, That the treasurer of the county of Kennebec
2 is authorized to procure by loan, on the faith and responsi-
3 bility of said county, a sum of money not exceeding twenty
4 thousand dollars, exclusive of and in addition to loans au-
5 thorized by section sixteen of chapter eighty of the revised
6 statutes, as it has been or may be amended, to be expended
7 by and under the direction of the county commissioners of
8 said county, for the purpose of paying off the indebtedness
9 of said county incurred by building a work-shop in connec-
10 tion with the county jail, and in paying the amount requir-
11 ed by chapter two hundred thirty-one of the Resolves of
12 the State of Maine for 1909, in aid of building the bridge
13 across the Kennebec river between the towns of Fairfield
14 and Clinton in the counties of Somerset and Kennebec, and

15 the said treasurer is hereby authorized to issue bonds of
16 said county with interest coupons attached, to the amount
17 of said loan; said bonds to bear interest, payable semi-annu-
18 ally, at a rate not exceeding four and one-half per cent per
19 annum, the principal to be payable at such times, not later
20 than twenty years from the date thereof, as said commis-
21 sioners may fix, and with or without provisions for a sink-
22 ing fund; said bonds to be signed by the treasurer and coun-
23 tersigned by the county commissioners of said county, and
24 the coupons to be signed by said treasurer.
