STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend chapter thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as amended by Chapter two hundred and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, relating to fishing in a portion of Cupsuptic stream, in Oxford county.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

So much of section two of chapter thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, as prohibits fishing in the ordinary way of angling with artificial flies, or fly fishing, in accordance with the general law of the state relating to fishing, from September fifteenth to

7 September thirtieth of each year, both days inclusive, from
8 the mouth of Cupsuptic stream at high water mark to Little
9 Falls on said stream, is hereby repealed.
