## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend chapter thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as amended by Chapter two hundred and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, relating to fishing in a portion of Cupsuptic stream, in Oxford county.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: So much of section two of chapter thirty-two of the Re-2 vised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six 3 of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, as 4 prohibits fishing in the ordinary way of angling with arti-5 ficial flies, or fly fishing, in accordance with the general law 6 of the state relating to fishing, from September fifteenth to 7 September thirtieth of each year, both days inclusive, from8 the mouth of Cupsuptic stream at high water mark to Little9 Falls on said stream, is hereby repealed.

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
