SENATE AMENDMENT "A" TO SENATE DOCUMENT No. 422, ENTITLED "AN ACT TO CREATE THE ANSON WATER DISTRICT."

Amend Senate Document No. 422 by inserting, after the 2 word "pond," in the third line of Section 2, the following: 3 'and any of the tributary lakes or streams thereof;' so that 4 said section as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 2. Said corporation is hereby authorized for the 6 purposes aforesaid, to take water from Great Embden pond 7 and to have co-equal rights in said Great Embden pond, and 8 any of the tributary lakes or streams thereof, with the Mad-9 ison Water Company, or to take water from Hancock pond, 10 or from Sand pond, or from Black Hill pond, in said Emb-11 den, or from the Mill stream in said Embden or Anson, or

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12 from Marshall's pond in said Anson; to erect and maintain 13 pumping stations with all the necessary appliances required 14 therefor; to erect and maintain reservoirs and standpipes; 15 to lay down and maintain pipes and aqueducts necessary for 16 the proper accumulating, conducting, discharging, distribut-17 ing and disbursing water, and forming proper reservoirs 18 therefor. Said corporation may take and hold by purchase 19 or otherwise any lands or real estate necessary therefor, and 20 may excavate through any lands when necessary for the 21 purposes of this corporation, within or without the limits of 22 said district.'
