AN ACT relative to the Use of Cinematographs using only  
Cellulose Acetate Films.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Chapter twenty-one of the public laws for the year nine-  
2 teen hundred and nine is hereby amended by adding at the  
3 end thereof the following:

'Sect. 7. The provisions of this act shall not apply to any  
5 cinematograph or similar apparatus operated with only cel-  
6 lulose acetate films not more than one inch and one-fourth  
7 in width and using only an enclosed incandescent lamp.'
