STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT relative to the Use of Cinematographs using only Cellulose Acetate Films.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter twenty-one of the public laws for the year nine-2 teen hundred and nine is hereby amended by adding at the 3 end thereof the following:

- 'Sect. 7. The provisions of this act shall not apply to any
- 5 cinematograph or similar apparatus operated with only cel-
- 6 lulose acetate films not more than one inch and one-fourth
- 7 in width and using only an enclosed incandescent lamp.
