# STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT additional to Chapter Forty-eight of the Revised Statutes, relating to Savings Banks and Institutions for Savings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. Savings banks and institutions for savings may, 2 by vote of the trustees of such corporation, when in the 3 judgment of said trustees such action is necessary to pay 4 depositors and to prevent loss by sales of assets, borrow 5 money within or without the state and may pledge bonds, 6 notes or other securities as collateral therefor.

Sect. 2. The trustees of such corporation shall cause a

2 copy of said vote to be sent forthwith to the bank commis-3 sioner and shall also notify him of any action taken there-4 under.
