STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT in Relation to the Improvement of Certain Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section 1. Whenever a Road Commissioner, officer or
2 employee of any city or town improves any highway with
3 the road machine or similar device after the first day of
4 August in any year, except light smoothing or maintenance
5 work, there shall be immediately placed a surface of gravel
6 to the average depth of six inches on the section of the
7 highway so improved.

Whenever a Road Commissioner, official or employee of 9 any city or town shall violate this act the State Highway 10 Commission shall withhold all moneys due such city or town
11 for such year as may be due such city or town for highway
12 purposes under Chapter one hundred thirty of the Laws of
13 nineteen hundred thirteen.

Sect. 2. This act shall not apply to such highways as are 2 improved under the direction of the State Highway Com-3 mission.
