STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT Construing Chapter Ninety-three of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred thirteen Relative to the Retirement of Veterans of the Civil War in the Service of the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter ninety-three of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred thirteen shall be so construed as to include a veteran of the Civil war who left the service of the State prior to the passage of said act who is otherwise entitled to its benefits by reason of length of service and inability for active duty; and his retirement pay, as specified in said act, shall be based on the compensation he was receiving from the

8 State at the time his work for the State ceased; but no
9 retirement pay shall be allowed for any time prior to the
10 date that said act took effect.
