STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to set off a part of the Town of Centerville and Annex the Same to the Town of Northfield.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

All that part of the town of Centerville in the County
2 of Washington, bounded and described as follows: Be-
3 ginning at the northwest corner of the town of Whitney-
4 ville and northerly continuing the same course as the west
5 line of Whitneyville to the Town of Northfield; thence
6 easterly by the south line of said Northfield to southeast
7 corner of said town; thence southerly by the easterly line
8 of said Centerville to the northeast corner of the town of

9 Marshfield; thence westerly by the north lines of said
10 Marshfield and Whitneyville to place of beginning, is here-
11 by set off from said town of Centerville and annexed to the
12 town of Northfield.
