AN ACT to amend Section one of Chapter thirty-five of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and eleven, relative to the better protection of forests from fire.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section one of chapter thirty-five of the public laws of 2 nineteen hundred and eleven is hereby amended by striking 3 out the words "wild lands of the state, over which said com- 4 missioner has jurisdiction," in the third and fourth lines 5 thereof, and inserting therefor the words 'wooded areas of 6 the state,' so that section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. It shall be the duty of the forest commissioner 8 whenever, in his judgment, the woodlands along the rail-

9 roads traversing the forest lands of the state, are in a dry  
10 and dangerous condition, to maintain a competent and effi-  
11 cient fire patrol along the right of way or lands of said rail-  
12 roads.'
