STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section one of Chapter thirty-five of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and eleven, relative to the better protection of forests from fire.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of chapter thirty-five of the public laws of

- 2 nineteen hundred and eleven is hereby amended by striking
- 3 out the words "wild lands of the state, over which said com-
- 4 missioner has jurisdiction," in the third and fourth lines
- 5 thereof, and inserting therefor the words 'wooded areas of
- 6 the state,' so that section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. It shall be the duty of the forest commissioner

8 whenever, in his judgment, the woodlands along the rail-

9 roads traversing the forest lands of the state, are in a dry 10 and dangerous condition, to maintain a competent and effi-11 cient fire patrol along the right of way or lands of said rail-12 roads.'
