STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend section seventy-one, chapter eighty-three of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter twenty-four of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred thirteen, relating to Attachments.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section seventy-one, chapter eighty-three, of the revised 2 statutes as amended by chapter twenty-four of the public 3 laws of nineteen hundred thirteen, is hereby amended by 4 striking out the words after the words "margin of the rec-5 ord of the attachment," so that said section seventy-one as 6 amended shall read as follows:

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'When an attachment is dissolved by judgment for the 8 defendant, the clerk of the court shall give any person apply-9 ing therefor a certificate of that fact, which the register of 10 deeds shall note on the margin of the record of the attach-11 ment; and before or after judgment, the plaintiff in such 12 suit may cause a discharge of such attachment, signed by him, 13 to be entered on the margin of the record thereof; or he 14 may give a certificate, signed, sealed and acknowledged by 15 him, that such attachment is, in whole or in part, discharged; 16 which the register of deeds shall record, with a reference 17 thereto on the margin of the record of the attachment.'
