# STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend the Charter of Dead River Log Driving Company, as amended by Chapter 233 of the Private and Special Laws of 1903.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section 2 of chapter 279 of private and special laws of
2 1880, as amended by section 2 of chapter 233 of private
3 and special laws of 1903, is hereby amended by striking out
4 the word "seven" in the second line of said section and
5 inserting in its place the word 'five,' so that said section as
6 amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 2. The officers of said company shall be a clerk,

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8 treasurer and board of five directors, all of whom shall be 9 chosen by ballot and sworn, and a master driver and such 10 other officers and agents as may be deemed necessary, may 11 be appointed by the directors unless chosen at the annual 12 meeting. The directors shall, at the first meeting, elect one 13 of their number, who shall be president of the company. 14 A majority of the board of directors shall constitute a quo-15 rum for doing business. The treasurer shall give bonds to 16 the acceptance of the directors.
