STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of the repair of bridges in the town of Dresden.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the 2 sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) to aid in the repair of 3 bridges in the town of Dresden, viz: two hundred and fifty 4 dollars (\$250) in the year one thousand nine hundred and 5 fifteen, and two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250) in the 6 year one thousand nine hundred and sixteen, provided the 7 town of Dresden appropriate five hundred dollars (\$500) 8 for the same purpose; both sums to be expended under the 9 supervision of the state highway department.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The town of Dresden is obliged to maintain the several bridges on the Eastern river in that town, all of which are draw bridges and require the attendance of a draw tender, and believe it is no more than fair that the state should now as in the past assist in the expense.
