STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Joint Special Committee on Salaries
and Fees of the Seventy-sixth Legislature.

Resolved, That the sum of one thousand six hundred sev-
2 enty-six dollars and eighty-five cents be and is hereby ap-
3 propriated for the payment of the expenses of the Joint
4 special committee on salaries and fees of the seventy-sixth
5 legislature, the same to be paid to the secretary of the com-
6 mittee, who shall immediately upon receipt thereof pay to
7 each member of the committee the sum of five dollars for
8 each day actually devoted to the work of the committee and
9 shall pay the several bills rendered to the committee for
10 expenses of the members and of the committee, taking re-
11 ceipts for all sums paid by him, which receipts he shall file
12 with the state auditor.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The expense incurred by the committee in the prosecution of its work consisted principally of the personal traveling and hotel expenses of the members, bills for folders, stationery, printing and postage; for advertising notices of hearings in two or more papers in each county and for stenographic work.
