STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, appropriating money to complete the re-planking
of the bridge at Wiscasset.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated in the
2 year nineteen hundred and fifteen the sum of six hundred
3 and fifty dollars to complete the re-planking of the Wis-
4 casset bridge, the same to be expended under the direction
5 of the highway department.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Seventy-sixth Legislature appropriated the sum of \$3,000.00 and the several towns of Wiscasset, Edgecomb, Boothbay, Boothbay Harbor and Southport a like sum of \$3,000.00, to re-plank the bridge at Wiscasset, a bridge about three-fourths of a mile long. The appropriation has been exhausted and the work not finished. The highway department estimates that the amount of \$650.00 will be needed to complete the work, hence this resolve.
