STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section Ninety-seven of Chapter Fifteen of the Revised Statutes as Amended by Chapter Forty-five of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Five, as Amended by Chapter Eighty-seven of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Nine, as Amended by Chapter Twenty-nine of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Eleven, as Amended by Chapter One Hundred Sixty-two of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Thirteen, Relating to the Appropriation of the Schooling of Children in Unorganized Townships.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section ninety-seven of chapter fifteen of the revised statutes as amended by chapter forty-five of the public laws of

3 nineteen hundred five, as amended by chapter eighty-seven
4 of the public laws of nineteen hundred nine, as amended by
5 chapter twenty-nine of the public laws of nineteen hundred
6 eleven, as amended by chapter one hundred sixty-two of the
7 public laws of nineteen hundred thirteen, is hereby further
8 amended by striking out the word "twenty-three" in the third
9 line thereof and substituting in place thereof the word
10 'twenty-five', so that said section when amended shall read
11 as follows:

 'Sect. 97. For the puprose of carrying out the provisions
13 of the three preceding sections, there is hereby appropriated
14 the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars annually, which
15 sum shall be deducted and set aside therefor by the treas-
16 urer of state from the annual school funds of the state.'
