STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to prevent the aiding or abetting of the escape of inmates of the Maine School for Feeble Minded.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Any person who shall aid or abet anyone committed to the
2 Maine School for Feeble Minded in escaping therefrom, or
3 who shall knowingly harbor or conceal anyone who has es-
4 caped from said school, shall be fined not less than fifty nor
5 more than one hundred dollars, or punished by imprisonment
6 in the county jail for not more than sixty days. Any fugi-
7 tive from said school may, on order of the superintendent
8 or hospital trustees, be arrested and returned to said school,

9 or to any officer or agent thereof, by any sheriff, constable
10 or police officer or other person; and may also be arrested
11 and returned by any officer or agent of said school.
