HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to restore the jurisdiction of Trial Justices in criminal offenses in the Towns of Kittery and York.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Trial justices in the county of York shall have concurrent
2 jurisdiction with the Yorkshire municipal court of all crim-
3 inal offenses and violations of town by-laws.
