STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, providing for an epidemic or emergency fund.

Resolved, That the sum of two thousand dollars annually
2 for two years is hereby appropriated as an epidemic or
3 emergency fund to be used, if necessary, by the state board
4 of health with the consent of the governor and council in
5 case of an epidemic of smallpox or other dangerous epi-
6 demic disease, or the invasion or threatened invasion of
7 any of those diseases into the state, and the governor is
8 hereby authorized to draw his warrant for the same, or
9 such part of the same, as may be needed out of any money
10 in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.
