RESOLVE, in favor of bridge in the town of Montville.

---

*Resolved,* That there be and hereby is appropriated the  
2 sum of one thousand dollars (\$1000) to aid the town of  
3 Montville in the reconstruction of a bridge in Montville  
4 on the main thoroughfare between Waterville and Belfast,  
5 provided there be appropriated by the town of Montville  
6 the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1000) for the same pur-  
7 pose, and further provided that any additional cost of said  
8 bridge above two thousand dollars shall be paid by the town  
9 of Montville. All appropriations to be expended under the  
10 supervision of the state highway department.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This bridge at the present time is in a positively dangerous condition and must be rebuilt at once. It carries a large amount of tourists and farm traffic, especially the tourist traffic. The town of Montville of its own resources is not able to reconstruct the bridge. The town has 100 miles of road and 10 bridges to maintain and last year the tax rate was 24½ mills.
