IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section 25 of Chapter 129 of the Revised
Statutes relating to the sale of Cigarettes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 25 of Chapter 129 of the revised statutes is hereby
2 amended by inserting after the word "year" in the third line
3 thereof the words 'or purchase for or at the solicitation of
4 any person under the age of twenty-one years,' so that said
5 section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 25. Whoever, by himself, his clerk, servant, or agent,
7 directly or indirectly sells, offers for sale, or has in his pos-
8 session with intent to sell, or gives away, to any person
9 under the age of twenty-one years, or purchases for or at

10 the solicitation of any person under the age of twenty-one
11 years, any cigarette, shall be punished by fine not exceed-
12 ing fifty dollars or by imprisonment not exceeding sixty
13 days. Trial justices and municipal and police courts shall
14 have jurisdiction of offenses arising under this section.'
