### STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

- AN ACT additional to Chapter Forty-Eight of the Revised Statutes, relating to Savings Banks and Institutions for Savings.
- Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
  Section I. Savings Banks and Institutions for Savings
  2 may, by vote of the trustees of such corporation, when in
  3 the judgment of said trustees such action is necessary to
  4 pay depositors and to prevent loss by sales of assets, bor5 row money within or without the State and may pledge
  6 bonds, notes or other securities as collateral therefor.

Sect. 2. The trustees of such corporation shall cause a 2 copy of said vote to be sent forthwith to the Bank Commis-3 sioner and shall also notify him of any action taken there-4 under.
