STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of the Farmington State Normal School
for the construction of a suitable building for the Household
Arts Department.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated in favor
2 of the Farmington State Normal School the sum of eight
3 thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred fifteen and
4 the sum of two thousand dollars for the year nineteen hun-
5 dred sixteen, such sums to be expended under the direction
6 of the trustees of the state normal schools for the construc-
7 tion and equipment of a suitable building for the household
8 arts department at said school.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The household arts department at the Farmington State Normal School is housed in a small frame building having no basement. The conditions are entirely unsatisfactory. The amount called for in the accompanying resolve would provide for the construction and furnishings of a suitable building for this department.
