STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of the Farmington State Normal School
for completing the furnishings at the dormitory of said
school.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated in favor
2 of the Farmington State Normal School the sum of five
3 thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred fifteen, such
4 sum to be expended under the direction of the trustees of
5 the state normal schools for completing the furnishings at
6 the dormitory of said school.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Seventy-sixth Maine Legislature made provision for the construction of a new dormitory at the Farmington State Normal School and for partial furnishing of the same. For completing the furnishings at this dormitory the sum of \$5000 is required.
