STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of the Madawaska Training School at Fort Kent for permanent improvements and repairs at said school.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated in favor 2 of the Madawaska Training School at Fort Kent the sum 3 of one thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred fif-4 teen and the sum of one thousand dollars for the year nine-5 teen hundred sixteen, such sums to be expended under the 6 direction of the trustees of the state normal schools for

7 permanent improvements and repairs at said school.
