RESOLVE, in favor of Michel B. Daly, of Portland.

Resolved, That there be paid to Michel B. Daly of Port-
2 land, twelve dollars a month, from the soldiers' pension
3 fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Michel B. Daly is seventy years old, is unable to work, and very near totally blind. He has no income with the exception of a small pension from the Federal Government, and supports his wife. He enlisted in the First Maine Battery, February 9, 1864, and was discharged July 15, 1865.
