STATE OF MAINE

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter thirty-five of the
Public Laws of nineteen hundred and eleven, relative to the
better protection of forests from fire.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of chapter thirty-five of the public laws of
2 nineteen hundred and eleven is hereby amended by striking
3 out the words "wild lands of the state, over which said
4 commissioner has jurisdiction," in the third and fourth
5 lines thereof, and inserting therefor the words 'forest lands
6 of the state,' so that said section as amended shall read as
7 follows:

'Section 1. It shall be the duty of the forest commis-
9 sioner whenever, in his judgment, the woodlands along the
10 railroads traversing the forest lands of the state, are in a

11 dry and dangerous condition, to maintain a competent and
 12 efficient fire patrol along the right of way of lands of said
 13 railroads.'
