STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Washington State Normal School at Machias for Removing and Remodeling the O'Brien House, so-called, at Said School.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated in favor 2 of the Washington State Normal School at Machias the sum 3 of one thousand five hundred dollars for the year nineteen 4 hundred fifteen and the sum of one thousand five hundred 5 dollars for the year nineteen hundred sixteen, such sums 6 to be expended under the direction of the trustees of the 7 state normal schools for removing and remodeling the 8 O'Brien House, so-called, at said school.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

On the land donated by the town of Machias to the State of Maine and on which the Washington State Normal School building was erected, stands a house commonly known as the O'Brien house which in its present condition and location is unsatisfactory. This house if removed to another site and completely remodeled could be used as a permanent residence for the principal of the school. The provision asked for in the accompanying resolve is for removing and remodeling this house.
