STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Farmington State Normal School for Repairs and Permanent Improvements.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated in favor 2 of the Farmington State Normal School the sum of five 3 hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred fifteen and 4 the sum of five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hun-5 dred sixteen, such sums to be expended under the direction 6 of the trustees of the state normal schools for general re-7 pairs and permanent improvements at said school.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

General repairs and permanent improvements are required at the Farmington State Normal School. Such repairs would include changes in the basement, repairs around the walls, provision of new floors in coat rooms, and provision for additional school furniture. The amount called for in the accompanying resolve would provide for such repairs and improvements.
