STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to equalize the salaries of the Judges of Probate.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Section 1. Judges of probate in the several counties shall
- 2 receive annual salaries from the treasuries of the counties
 - 3 in quarterly payments on the first days of January, April,
 - 4 July and October as follows:
 - 5 Androscoggin, one thousand dollars.
 - 6 Aroostook, one thousand dollars.
 - 7 Cumberland, twenty-five hundred dollars.
 - 8 Franklin, six hundred dollars.
 - 9 Hancock, one thousand dollars.
 - 10 Kennebec, seventeen hundred dollars.
 - 11 Knox, seven hundred dollars.

- 12 Lincoln, five hundred dollars.
- 13 Oxford, eight hundred fifty dollars.
- 14 Penobscot, eighteen hundred dollars.
- 15 Piscataquis, six hundred dollars.
- 16 Sagadahoc, eight hundred dollars.
- 17 Somerset, eight hundred dollars.
- 18 Waldo, seven hundred dollars.
- 19 Washington, eight hundred dollars.
- 20 York, thirteen hundred dollars.

Sect. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the
2 provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

Sect. 3. Any official now receiving a salary greater than
2 is herein provided shall continue to receive his present sal-
3 ary until the expiration of his term of office.
