STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to equalize the salaries of county attorneys.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Section 1. County attorneys of the several counties shall
- 2 receive annual salaries from the state treasury in monthly
- 3 payments on the last day of each month, as follows:
- 4 Androscoggin, twelve hundred dollars.
- 5 Aroostook, fifteen hundred dollars.
- 6 Cumberland, seventeen hundred dollars.
- 7 Franklin, five hundred dollars.
- 8 Hancock, seven hundred fifty dollars.
- 9 Kennebec, fourteen hundred dollars.
- 10 Knox, seven hundred dollars.
- 11 Lincoln, five hundred dollars.

- 12 Oxford, nine hundred dollars.
13 Penobscot, fifteen hundred dollars.
14 Piscataquis, six hundred dollars.
15 Sagadahoc, six hundred dollars.
16 Somerset, eight hundred fifty dollars.
17 Waldo, five hundred dollars.
18 Washington, nine hundred dollars.
19 York, twelve hundred dollars.
20 Cumberland County, assistant county attorney, nine hun-
21 dred dollars. And no other fees, costs or emoluments shall
22 be allowed them.

Sect. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the
2 provisions of this act are hereby repealed.
