STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to equalize the salaries of county treasurers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The county treasurers in the several counties

- 2 shall receive annual salaries from the treasuries of the
- 3 counties in quarterly payments on the first days of January,
- 4 April, July and October, as follows:
- 5 Androscoggin, thirteen hundred dollars.
- 6 Aroostook, eight hundred dollars.
- 7 Cumberland, twenty-one hundred dollars.
- 8 Franklin, four hundred dollars.
- 9 Hancock, five hundred dollars.
- 10 Kennebec, fourteen hundred dollars.
- 11 Knox, four hundred dollars.

- 12 Lincoln, three hundred dollars.
- 13 Oxford, six hundred fifty dollars.
- 14 Penobscot, thirteen hundred dollars.
- 15 Piscataquis, four hundred dollars.
- 16 Sagadahoc, three hundred fifty dollars.
- 17 Somerset, six hundred dollars.
- 18 Waldo, four hundred dollars.
- 19 Washington, seven hundred dollars.
- 20 York, eight hundred fifty dollars.
 - Sect. 2. Each of the counties above named shall pay the
 - 2 premium on the official bond of its treasurer.
 - Sect. 3. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the
 - 2 provisions of this act are hereby repealed.
