STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT for the Better Protection of Shell Fish within the
Town of Eliot, in the County of York.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No shell fish shall be taken from any flats
2 within the limits of the town of Eliot, in York County, ex-
3 cept by written permit of the municipal officers of the said
4 town of Eliot, and payment to the said town for the privilege
5 at such price as said town may establish at any town meeting,
6 any existing laws to the contrary notwithstanding; provided,
7 that without such permit, any inhabitant within said town,
8 or any person temporarily resident therein, or the riparian
9 owner of any such flats, may take therefrom for the immedi-

10 ate use of himself or his family, not exceedinng one bushel
11 at one tide.

Sect. 2. Any person taking shell fish contrary to the pro-
2 visions of this act, shall be punished for each offense by a
3 fine not exceeding ten dollars, or by imprisonment not ex-
4 ceeding thirty days or by both.
