STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to define and make certain the authority of school boards over school grounds, property and buildings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. That all school grounds, property and buildings be solely in charge of the school boards of the several cities and towns, and that repairs and alterations be made and new buildings be built solely under the authority of the said school boards.

Sect. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.
