STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE for an Appropriation to Repair Bridges in Township 29 M. D., Washington County.

Resolved, That the sum of One Hundred Dollars be and 2 is hereby appropriated for the purpose of repairing the 3 bridges across Northeast Brook and Canoe Brook in Township 4 ship No. 29 M. D., Washington County. The same to be 5 expended under the direction of the County Commissioners of said County.

The bridges across the Northeast Brook and Canoe Brook in Township 29, M. D., Washington County. The covering of these bridges are made of spruce poles and covered with earth. Owing to the automobile travel on this road, which is the direct road between Bangor and Grand Lake Stream, it will be necessary to have different stringers and different covering than above described, and above resolve is to put in stringers and planks to make it safe for automobile travel.
