STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT in relation to the improvement of highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Whenever a road commissioner, officer or
2 employee of any city or town improves any highway with
3 the road machine or similar device after the tenth day of
4 August in any year, except light smoothing or maintenance
5 work, there shall be immediately placed a surface of gravel
6 to the average depth of six inches on the section of the high-
7 way so improved.

Whenever a road commissioner, official or employee of any
9 city or town shall violate this act, the state highway com-
10 mission shall withhold for such year all moneys due such

11 city or town for highway purposes under chapter one hun-
12 dred thirty of the laws of nineteen hundred thirteen.

Sect. 2. This act shall not apply to such highways as are
2 improved under the direction of the state highway com-
3 mission.
