STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to close Socatean Stream to power boats.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any steam boat or

- 2 motor boat, by whatever power propelled, to navigate the
- 3 waters of Socatean stream or bay adjacent and tributary to
- 4 Moosehead lake above the point near the outlet of said
- 5 stream where fishing buoys are now located.
 - Sect. 2. This act shall not apply to steam boats or motor
- 2 boats in use in connection with lumbering operations.
 - Sect. 3. Whoever violates the provisions of this act shall
- 2 pay a fine of twenty dollars and costs for each offense.
