STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of the town of Trescott to aid in repairing its highways.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the

- 2 sum of \$250 in the year 1915 and \$250 in the year 1916
- 3 for the purpose of repairing the highways of the town of
- 4 Trescott, in the county of Washington, both sums to be
- 5 expended under the supervision of the state highway de-
- 6 partment.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The town of Trescott has 37 miles of highway, and seven bridges ranging from 15 to 30 feet between abutments, with the valuation of only \$59,835, and a tax rate of \$.043 on full valuation. There is not a manufacturing establishment or a store in the town.
