STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of State Pension Clerk.

Resolved, That the state pension clerk is hereby authorized to expend such sum under the direction of the governor and council, not exceeding four hundred dollars yearly, as may be necessary to properly examine the claims presented to his office, the same to be paid out of the appropriation for state pensions for the years nineteen hundred and fifteen and nineteen hundred and sixteen.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

In order that the appropriation for soldiers' pensions may be properly expended, it will be necessary for said clerk to make a personal investigation of the pensioners in the different cities and towns throughout the state.
