STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to extend the charter of the World's Standard
Insurance Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The rights, powers and privileges of the World's Standard
2 Insurance Company which were granted by chapter two
3 hundred and nine of the private and special laws of the
4 state of Maine for the year nineteen hundred eleven are
5 hereby extended for two years additional, from the date
6 of the approval of this act, and the persons named in said
7 act, their associates and successors, shall have the rights,
8 powers and privileges that were granted to them by said act
9 to be exercised by them for the same purposes as specified
10 in said act.
