STATE OF MAINE

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN**

AN ACT to amend paragraph 27, of section one of chapter 116, of the Revised Statutes, relating to the compensation of the subordinate officers of the Maine State Prison.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Paragraph 27 of section 1 of chapter 116 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 54 of the public laws of 1907, and chapter 197 and 205 of the public laws of 1909, is hereby amended so that said paragraph, as amended, shall read as follows:

Warden of the state prison, two thousand five hundred dollars, which shall be in full for all services, including the duty of receiving and paying out money under general provisions of law; he shall have the use, without charge, of

10 such parts of the keeper's house and buildings of the state,
11 appurtenant to the prison and yard, as the governor and
12 council may direct, and fuel for his own use; deputy war-
13 den, one thousand five hundred dollars; clerk, twelve hun-
14 dred dollars; officer of the guard, eight hundred dollars;
15 day guards, seven hundred twenty dollars each; physician,
16 five hundred dollars; gate keeper, seven hundred twenty
17 dollars; commissary, two hundred dollars in addition to his
18 salary as guard; chaplain and teacher, fifteen hundred dol-
19 lars; night guards, seven hundred eighty dollars; wagon
20 master, seven hundred twenty dollars; yard master, seven
21 hundred twenty dollars; night watchman, seven hundred
22 twenty dollars.'
