STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend section two of chapter thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, relating to fishing through the ice in Martin pond, sometimes called Long pond, in The Forks Plantation, in Somerset county.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

So much of section two of chapter thirty-two of the re-
2 vised statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six
3 of the public laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, as pro-
4 hibits fishing through the ice, on Wednesday and Saturday
5 of each week, in accordance with the general law of the

6 state relating to ice fishing, in Martin pond, sometimes called
7 Long pond, situated in The Forks Plantation, in the county
8 of Somerset, is hereby repealed.
