### STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT additional to chapter thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, relating to fishing in certain waters in Township Number Six, Range Two, N. B. K. P., or Forsyth Township, so-called, and in Township Number Six, Range One, N. B. K. P., or Holeb Township, so-called, in the County of Somerset.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section 1. No person shall take, catch or kill more than
2 five pounds of fish in all in any one day in Big Turner pond,
3 Little Turner pond, or in the Calf Pasture, so-called, adja4 cent to said Big Turner pond, in Township Number Six,
5 Range Two, N. B. K. P., or Forsyth Township, so-called,

6 in the County of Somerset, or in Fish pond, Little Fish pond7 or McKenney pond, in Township Number Six, Range One,8 N. B. K. P., or Holeb Township, so-called, in said county.

No person shall have in possession in any one day more to than five pounds of fish in all taken in either of the aboveti named ponds.

Sect. 2. No person shall fish for, take, catch or kill any 2 kind of fish at any time in Brook Number One, so-called, or 3 in Brook Number Two, so-called, above the railroad track 4 above Lowelltown, in the County of Franklin.

No person shall have in possession any kind of fish taken 6 in violation of any provision of this section.

Sect. 3. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall 2 pay a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more than thirty 3 dollars and costs for each offense; and in addition thereto 4 one dollar for each fish taken, caught, killed or had in pos-5 session in violation of any provision of this act.
